Prepare your school for a successful event

One MONTH prior:

- Provide the shipping address of the school.
- Review our [Family Math Game Night](#) website.
- Send out Invitations/RSVP's to plan for the evening.
- Create a plan to distribute your board games at the end of the night. (e.g., raffle, pass out after the event, etc.)



One WEEK prior:

- Email us with a head count.
- Get the word out – social, announcements, emails, flyer.
- Gather staff for the event and assign roles: check-in table, food tables, games tables, etc.
- **OPTIONAL:** Have students play some of the games prior to the event so they're ready to teach their families!

DAY of event:

- Set up a large space (gym, cafeteria, etc.) with tables to accommodate your RSVPs.
- Game helpers arrive one hour prior to set-up and learn the games.
- Prepare check-in and food tables.
- *Play and have fun!*
